Proof of residency includes your Council tax reference number along with one other document from the following list: A drivers licence, TV licence, rent book, tenancy agreement or utility bill dated within the last 3 months (e.g. electricity, gas, water, broadband contract, or landline phone).

An additional SIF form must be completed if applying for a faith school or own admission authority school.

**Courses for Parents/Carers in 2024:** Cranbrook School are pleased to announce that we will resume running courses in partnership with the Redbridge Institute of Adult Education from 2024. Courses will be held at Cranbrook Primary School in the Dance studio on Mondays. Parents will be required to enrol for each course and a strict waiting list will be in operation. Courses are free to attend and a certificate will be awarded at the end of each course. Please note that there are no crèche facilities available for any of the courses.

To be eligible to enrol on a course, parents/carers will need to provide a UK/EU passport or a Biometric Residence Permit (for non UK/EU passport holders). Asylum seekers will need to provide their ARC card (which is issued by the Home Office whilst their application is being processed). If an individual does not possess an ARC card, then they must provide their Home Office letter, (with the date mentioned in the letter), to establish that they have lived in the UK for more than 6 months.

#### <u>Celebrating Cultural Connections-Celebrating diversity</u> <u>across our school:</u>

#### **Itzhak Perlman**

Born in Tel Aviv, Israel, Perlman contracted polio at the age of four, and has used mobility aids ever since. He moved to the U.S. at age 13 to attend Juilliard, appearing on the Ed Sullivan show as a teenager and making his Carnegie Hall debut at 18 years old. Perlman has been called one of the best violinists of all time, and has appeared with many of the world's major orchestras, including the New York Philharmonic, Chicago Symphony Orchestra, Berlin Philharmonic, and Boston Symphony Orchestra. Itzhak Perlman is now best known as a classical musician, conductor, and educator. His music has earned him 16 Grammy awards and 4 Emmy awards, he has performed for multiple U.S. presidents, and given concerts all over the world.
